

How did this intolerable situation come about? If you will recall, about a year ago I and other members of CAL SEIA attended and testified at Public Hearings held by CSLB to discuss the need a Solar License. The Solar Industry was indeed a minority representing this issue. hearings were literally packed with members and lobbyists from the Sheetmetal Workers and Plumbing Trades who sent one after another before the Board to explain that solar was merely an extension of their existing trade knowledge and no special knowledge of training is needed "after all, we were installing solar systems 50 years ago."

The preponderance of evidence overwhelmed the Board and the



Supplemental only classification was born.

CAL SEIA's position on this issue continues to be that CSLB should establish a Primary Solar Contractors Classification which will allow a Solar Contractor to install all solar systems.

I have recently written to Mr. Mel Cooper, Registrar of Contractors in Sacramento asking for a meeting with him regarding this problem. I shall again request hearings on the subject.

Through this letter, I am requesting that those members of CAL SEIA who are interested and are willing to testify on behalf of a Primary Solar License, correspond with the CAL SEIA office in Sacramento immediately giving your points of view and written testimony. I would like to see a show of force from the industry on this issue should it go to hearings. This matter has far reaching ramifications for you and for the industry.

3. DEPUTY UNDER-SECRETARY OF ENERGY VISITS CALIFORNIA

Jackson S. Gouraud, Deputy Under-Secretary of Energy and senior marketing officer of the Department, was in California on March 22 and 23 visiting with CAL SEIA members in order to get a view of the industry and where it is going in our State.

Mr. Gouraud has among his principal responsibilities the commercialization of all alternative energy sources and techniques and the educating of the American public about the reality and seriousness of the energy problems.

CAL SEIA members met in San Diego for lunch with Mr. Gouraud and reported to him that solar was gaining in their area and that business was good.

Mr. Gouraud then flew to
Los Angeles where he met with
members of the Board of CAL SEIA
Mr. Gouraud mentioned that he
had been in Florida, New Mexico,
and Arizona before arriving in
California and had met with the
solar industry in those states
also. He mentioned that his
meeting in San Diego was the
first "upbeat" meeting he had
had with the solar industry and
felt the same about his meeting
with the CAL SEIA members who
met with him in Los Angeles.

The Under-Secretary mentioned that there is \$800 million in the DOE budget for alternative energy and that they believe that a major marketing thrust with more good press was one of

the main purposes of his job. He said that he is working with the National SEIA in this regard.

Mr. Gouraud said that he considers the State of California to be the trendsetter in the solar business.

behalf of the industry."


WORKSHOP ON SOLAR ENERGY LAW

STAFF CHANGES AT CAL SEIA

Senator Alan Sieroty, D-Los Angeles, has introduced Senate Bill 946 which would mandate that Sidential swimming pools con-Dructed after July 1, 1980, get at least half of their heating requirements from solar energy.

Exemptions would be made for applicants who could show a solar energy system would not be cost efficient in the long run or where restrictions on the sunlight available made the system unfeasible.

Senator Sieroty said that this measure was aimed at encouraging conservation of energy.


9. VIC Conserve-A-Rama
